### Job Description:

The La Jolla Band of Luiseño Indians is seeking candidates for multiple Zipline Adventure Guide positions. The primary responsibilities of the position are to ensure guest safety, generate excitement, and create an unforgettable experience for each customer. Adventure Guides will report to the Zipline Operations Manager with general oversight from the Tribal Administrator and La Jolla Tribal Council.

- Execute daily opening and closing procedures of zipline course
- Conduct complete inspections of all course components and gear
- Ensure the highest level of customer safety is maintained at all times
- Provide orientation to each tour group
- Assist with zipline course maintenance efforts
- Maintain clear communication staff and supervisor
- Assist where needed per Manager
